

Submission Review Format: Requirements for ISECON Papers

ISECON uses two formats in its document processing. When your document is initially submitted, it must be in “Submission Review Format.” When your document is accepted, it must be submitted in “Final Publication Format.” This page specifies “Submission Review Format.”

- 1) The head of your article must include ONLY the following information.
 - a. Title of article
 - b. Abstract—250 words max
 - c. Keywords

- 2) The head of your article must NOT identify the authors nor their affiliations. This is to facilitate blind review. Authorship and affiliation data will be entered separately. All co-authors should be identified at this time.

- 3) The body of your article must be formatted as follows.
 - a. Microsoft Word document
 - b. Font: Verdana if available, otherwise Times New Roman
 - c. Size: 12 point
 - d. Double space
 - e. Margins: 1.5 left margin, 1.25 all other margins
 - f. **Maximum length: 25 pages** (including all figures / tables / references)

As this is a peer-reviewed conference, **all authors (including co-authors) who submit papers will be asked to peer review other submissions.** Our goal is to provide a 30-day response to our authors following each deadline date. Therefore, your timely assistance is crucial and greatly appreciated.

At least one of the paper’s authors must register and present the paper at the ISECON 2006 Conference (November 2-5, Dallas).
